THE END OF INTELLECTUAL OUTPUT 1 (IO1): THE AWARENESS AND CAPACITY BUILDING ACCESS4ALL COURSES-

IO1 has just come to an end. As a highlight, the consortium partners have developed different **Real Case Scenarios (RCS)** addressing policies and/or actions of local authorities, municipalities or public bodies in their countries related to accessibility and disability. They entail actually short, but meaningful, complementary studies to present and promote paradigms and **good practices of accessibility** in a range of situations, as well as to estimate the average amounts of budgeting, constructions and implementation limitations in regards with disabilities.

REAL CASE SCENARIOS

SPAIN

“Accessible Medicine Plus”, ONCE Foundation.

Free Mobile application to provide information on medicines to groups with some type of disabilities and the elderly .It is equipped with tools like scan drug code, pharmacy locator and a system of alert whether it detects an incompatibility of medicines with your allergies,

FRANCE

«Centre de Rééducation et d'Insertion Professionnelle » (CRIP). L'Union pour la gestion des établissements de caisses d'assurance maladie (UGEAM)

CRIP takes care of workers who suffered an accident or occupational illness and can no longer exercise their profession. It considers a professional retraining.

AUSTRIA

Project ARCHES - Inclusive Art Education. Arts History Museum of Vienna (Kunsthistorisches Museum Wien).

A barrier-free APP “ARCHES KHM für alle” where to find detailed object descriptions for blind and visually impaired people, as videos in sign language. The interactive tactile relief of Pieter Bruegel the Elder, The Nest Robberis set up in combination with a computer intuitively so that visually impaired people immediately receive audio information when they click

ITALY

LIBERAMENTE- "the beach accessible to all", in the Municipality of Cerveteri.

It is worth noting the measure of “Chairs JOB”, wheelchairs designed specifically for the beach, as they do not sink into the sand, that allow people with disabilities to access the water in real comfort. They also count with specialized assistance staff.

GREECE

“Corfu Accessible Beaches Project”.

Among other measures, it highlights the System for Blind People. An innovative system to give signals to people inside the sea with information regarding their exact location, the depth helping them orient themselves while they are in the sea. It ensures a significant level their independence while swimming.

CYPRUS

Project HERMES II. Paralimni coast.

Paralimni coast's it can be found “Seatrac” ramps. That is, special ramps with a wheelchair on rails that moves from the shore into the sea and back. Moreover, it is a free and unassisted service that operates with a remote control. There are five beaches more.
